What is a dental examination?

Here at Inglewood House, we like to provide the very best in dental care and service. Our dental examination incorporates a ten point dental health check, providing you with an extensive investigation into your oral health and well-being.

Ten point health check

- 1 Examination of your teeth to determine whether they are strong and healthy.
- 2 Review of the current health and strength of any fillings and restorations.
- 3 Assessment of the health of your gums as these are fundamental to keeping your teeth for life.
- 4 Investigation into the presence of plaque as this is the main cause of tooth decay and gum disease.
- 5 Inspection of the inside of your mouth for any signs of oral cancer (cheeks, lips, tongue, palate and floor of mouth).
- 6 Assessment of the bone which supports your teeth.
- 7 Examination of your jaw and surrounding glands.
- 8 Completion/review of a smile analysis, outlining any concerns about your oral health.
- 9 The smile analysis will include a review of your feelings and any aspirations about the appearance of your teeth and smile.
- 10 Confidential discussion regarding any medical conditions and/or any medication you are taking which may affect your dental health.

Did you know?

Chewing sugar-free gum stimulates saliva by up to ten times the normal rate and has been shown to help reduce tooth decay by up to 40%. To reduce the length of time that teeth are attacked by acid you should chew sugar-free gum for 20 minutes after you have eaten, when you cannot brush your teeth.

Although chewing sugar-free gum can work wonders it is not recommended for children under six years old.
